



Created in 1985, the European Society for Pigment Cell Research is a multi-disciplinary community of clinicians and scientists interested in investigating normal and pathological functions of pigment cells.

The 26th European Society for Pigment Cell Research meeting will gather scientists and clinicians in the fields of dermatology, ophthalmology, physiology, genetics, genomics, chemistry and computational biology.
